The Hermosa Study - Teens in Salinas - 2016

- Enrolled 100 Latina teens
- Inventoried the personal care products they were using
- Took urine samples to measure the chemicals in their bodies
- Gave them low-chemical products for 3 days
- Collected a second urine sample
- Compared levels of hormone disruptors before and after the intervention




Healthy Breast Cell Donors



Our Healthy Intervention

- Participants used only XElow personal care products provided by Breast Cancer Over Time for 28 days between cell donations
- Participants kept logs of all products used for 28 days between cell donations



Take Home Message - Check your Products! You are Beautiful Without Them!
