Presentation Topic: <u>Refugee Health in Washington State</u> - This presentation will provide an overview of refugee resettlement in WA State, describe the purpose of the domestic health screening exam for refugees in WA State, and provide examples of how screening information is used to inform public health practice and promote refugee health.

Speaker: Azadeh Tasslimi is an epidemiologist with the Refugee Health Program at Washington State Department of Health (DOH) where she collaborates with local domestic health screening clinic providers to monitor the health of newly arrived refugees and helps conduct evaluations to guide health program activities for refugee communities. Prior to joining the Refugee Health Program she worked in communicable disease surveillance at DOH and was an analyst at Rutgers University for an evaluation of the cost-effectiveness of child pneumococcal conjugate vaccination in Gavi-eligible countries. She received her MPH in Epidemiology from Rutgers University School of Public Health and her BA in Biology from Boston University.
