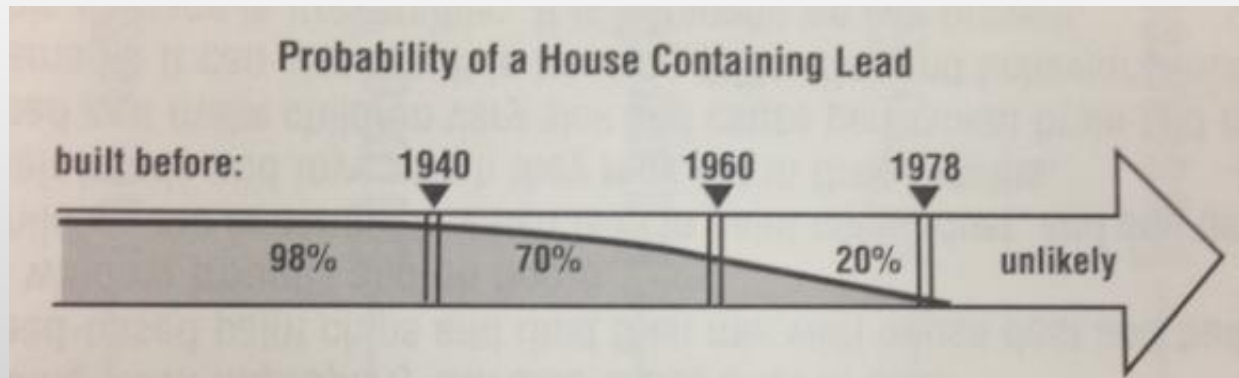

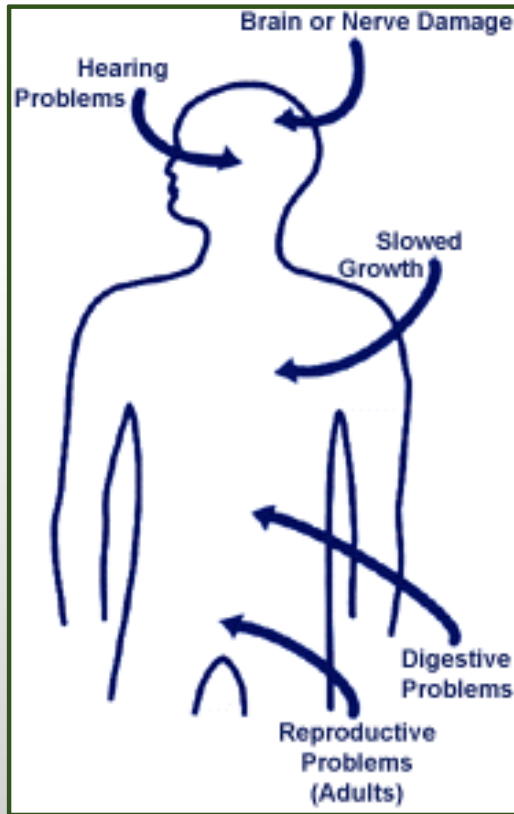

## Prevent Childhood Lead Poisoning

### The Impact

**535,000**

U. S. children ages 1 to 5 years have blood lead levels high enough to damage their health.



**24 million**

homes in the U.S. contain deteriorated lead-based paint and elevated levels of lead-contaminated house dust.



**4 million** of these are home to young children.

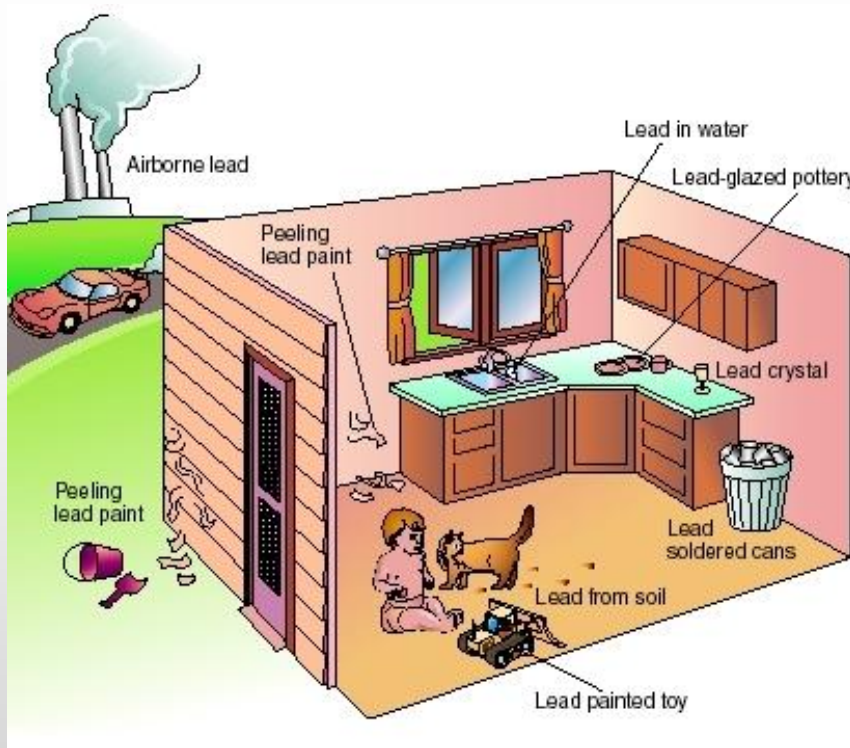

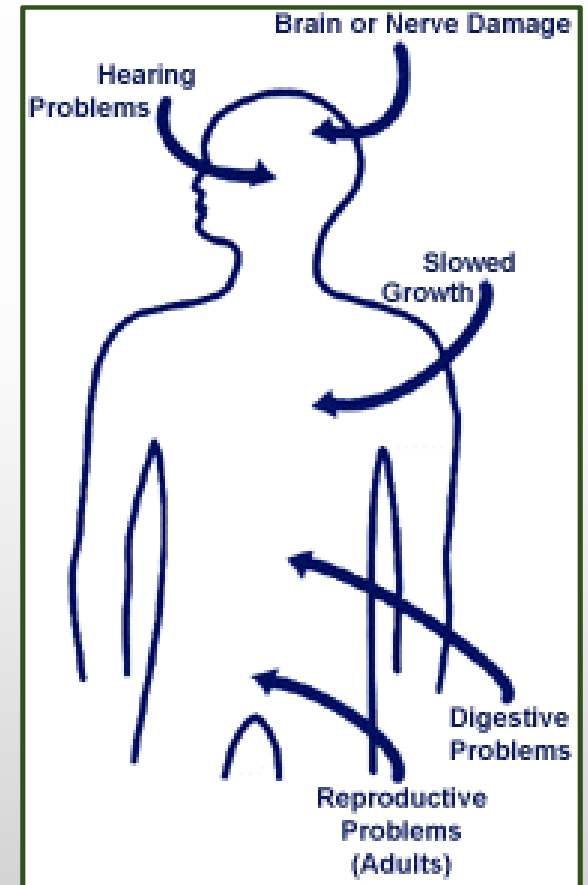

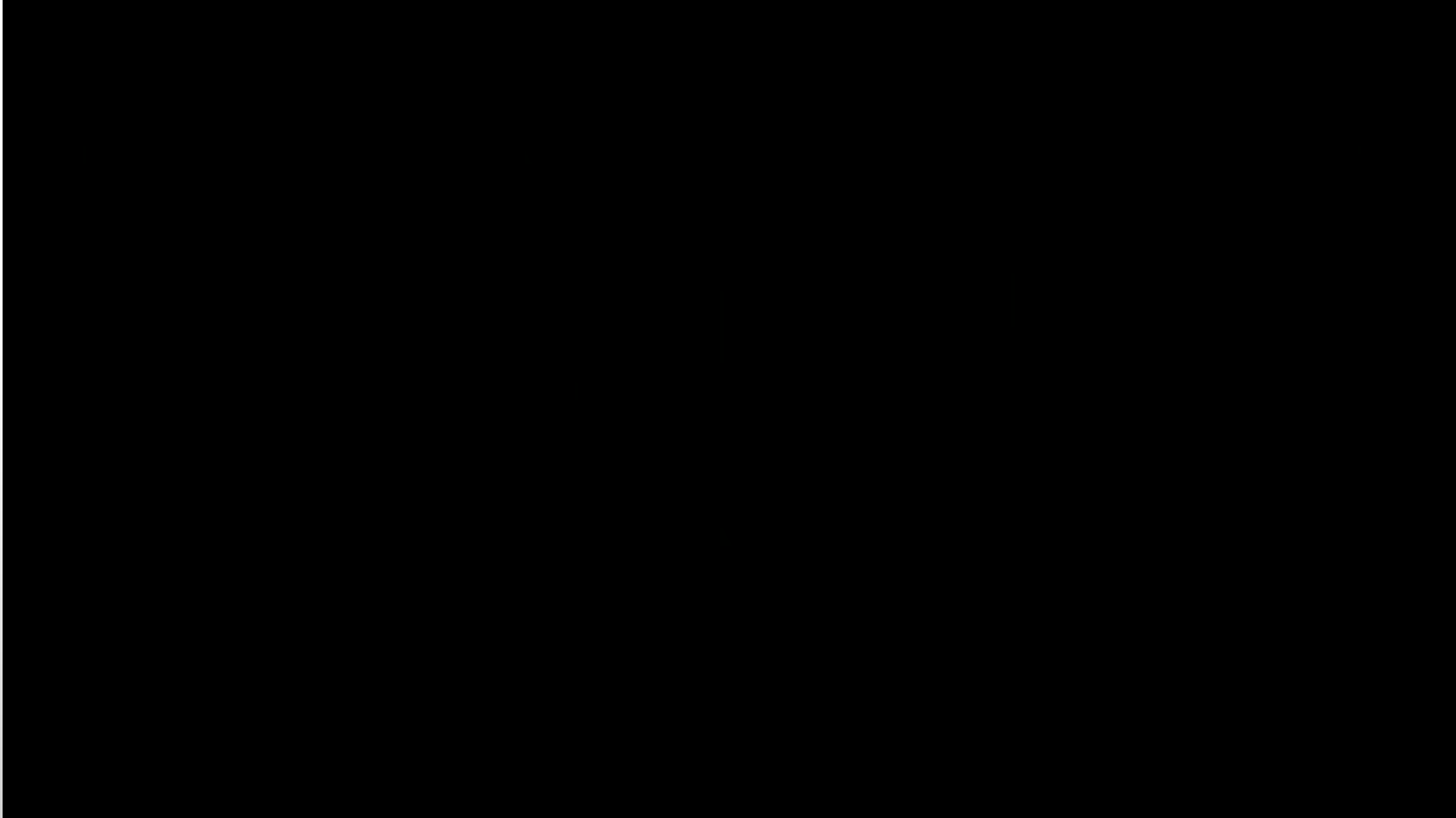
